

## ARTS & CULTURE PROJECTS

The Strategic Objective of the arts, Culture and Heritage programme is to advance artistic disciplines into viable opportunities for the community of Bokone Bophirima.

In order to be considered proposals must demonstrate how they: Invest in the development of cultural workers in the Villages, Townships and Small Dorpies. Develop and promote the products and services of creative clusters and enterprises in Bokone Bophirima.

**Projects to be implemented between September 2017 and March 2018.**

Application forms are available on the Departmental website on [www.nwpg.gov.za/cata](http://www.nwpg.gov.za/cata) Head and District Offices. The application forms should be submitted at the reception desk of Gaabomotho building and district offices. The following documents must accompany your application form:

- Certified copy of Registration Certificate
- Audited Financial Statements (Not more than 1 year old) or letter from the auditor for new companies or organisations
- Signed and dated Constitution / Articles and Memorandum of Association / Trust Deed/ Company profile
- Original Tax Clearance Certificate and a Certified copy of a Tax Exemption letter for NPOs
- Certified copy of ID from the Project Coordinators
- Certified copy of the last 3 months bank statements/ or letter from the bank for new accounts
- Costed Project Implementation plan
- Only Bokone Bophirima based organisations may apply and projects must be implemented within Bokone Bophirima. No faxed or e-mailed copies will be allowed. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be processed. All required documentation must be attached to the application form
- Previous Applicants must have submitted all outstanding Progress Reports on any grants previously received from the Department of Culture Arts and traditional affairs.
- Organisations must be registered for vendor number on the database of the Provincial Department of Finance
- Non-Compliant applications will not be considered (All the above required documents must be submitted at the time of applications)
- Applicants that have received funding for the past three terms will not be considered for funding.

**NB: - It is important that all Organisations that previously submitted their proposals to the Department must resubmit .**

- Amounts exceeding R150,000,00 will not be considered.
- Consideration for funding will be at the discretion of the adjudication committee.
